

Spotlight on “Fundraising” with Gift Cards

- How does it work?
- How does Assumption Regional Catholic School (ARCS) raise money selling gift cards?

Assumption Regional Catholic School’s non-profit status allows us to participate in a “Scrip Program” where retailers sell us gift cards at a discount. This discount is called the “non-profit contribution”.

When you shop with ARCS Gift Cards and/or give them as a gift, you enable ARCS to grab “non-profit contributions” a.k.a. FREE MONEY!

NEW THIS YEAR.....To take full advantage of this opportunity, ARCS offers families the option of allocating a portion of the non-profit contributions generated by their orders toward their ARCS tuition bill for the next year.

Non-profit contributions vary by retailer and some offer increased contribution “specials” throughout the year. The full non-profit contribution rate is listed on the paper order forms as well as online at www.shopwithscrip.com.

When you complete the Scrip Program Agreement, you designate the allocation of the non-profit contributions, between ARCS and your tuition account. This is a 50/50 split. The non-profit contribution money that you allocate to ARCS goes directly towards our operating budget. Achieving our total operating budget goals allows ARCS to maintain our educational program and our building at our current tuition rate.

It is important to note that ARCS makes NO money from this program until you use it.
