Attached is the summer reading book report project. The children are required to read one of the following books and complete the book project.

- Encyclopedia Brown, Boy Detective by Donald J. Sobol
- Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing by Judy Blume
- Any of the "I Survived" books by Lauren Tarshis
- Frindle by Andrew Clements
- Katarina Ballerina by Tiler Peck and Kyle Harris

Please follow the guidelines listed below to complete the book report:

1. Please complete the poster project on the attached size poster or a white piece of construction paper.
2. The summary section must be completed in sentences, with correct spelling and punctuation. Please color your illustrations.
3. The report will be graded on completeness, neatness and if all directions were followed.
4. The reports are due on the first day of school.

Please practice your cursive handwriting and math facts this summer. Students will be taking a math fact quiz during the first week of school. They will also take timed math drills each week during the school year. We recommend multiplication and division flash cards which can be made at home or purchased at most dollar stores. A good website to practice math facts is www.multiplication.com, www.math-drills.com and www.funbrain.com.

 - The names of the main characters
 - 2-3 adjectives about your book

- ✓ Plan out your poster first so you will have room for everything.
- ✓ Use bright colors.
- ✓ You can write directly on the poster or type the elements out on the computer and cut out and glue the printouts to your poster board.
