

# 5th Grade Summer Reading 2022-2023

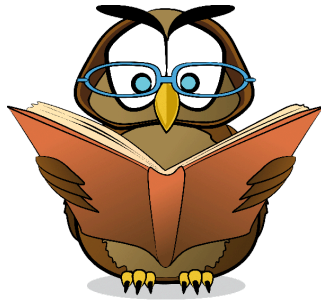
